ALL that certain parcel or lot of land situated on the south side of Ansel School Road, about two miles northward from the City of Greer, Mead Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and having courses and distances according to survey and plat by Terry T. Dill, L. S., dated March 20, 1973, as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of the Ansel School Road, corner of Patterson property, and running thence N. 16-1/2 E. 20 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 16-1/2 W. 20 feet to an iron pipe; thence N. 16-1/2 W. 20 feet to an iron pin, corner of lot belonging to Eddie E. Pollard; thence along line of same, N. 16-1/2 E. 20 feet to a point in the center of the Ansel School Road, iron pin tack on bank; thence along said road, S. 19-00 E. 100 feet to the beginning.
