

CONTINUATION OF DESCRIPTION (PAGE 1)

ALSO:

ALL that lot, piece, or parcel of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 335 on plat 6 of the property of Tryon Development Co., known as Lake Lanier and duly recorded in the Office of the RMC for Greenville County, said lot having a frontage of 54.9 feet, a rear width of 66 feet, and a depth on one side of 125 feet and 179 feet on the other.

THIS being the same property conveyed to the grantor herein by deed of Mary Frances Wilbanks Langley dated April 6, 1978, said deed being recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book 1077 at Page 240.

Q. Donaldson, T. A. Bellotte, Mrs. Nancy Johnson and Johnson Street.
