This is an action to abandon or close certain alleys located in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina pursuant to §57-9-10 of the 1976 Code of Laws of South Carolina, as Amended. It appears and the Court finds that prior to filing the Petition in this case, notice of intention to file was published once a week, for three (3) consecutive weeks, in the Greenville Piedmont, a newspaper published in Greenville County, South Carolina, where such alleys are situated. Further, the Court finds that notice was sent by mail, requiring a return receipt, to the last known address of all abutting property owners whose property would be affected by any such change. The Court further finds that the parties Plaintiff are interested persons and have standing to bring this action. It further appears that the appropriate parties have been named as Defendants in this action, both in their own capacity and for the benefit of the general public; and it further appears that the City of Greenville, South Carolina has, also been properly made a party to this proceeding.
