By deed recorded July 18, 1952 in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 459, Page 275, said John Robert French and Hester Rhoda French conveyed to G. M. Marks an undivided one sixth interest in the above described property, so that together with his ownership of an undivided one third interest, he became vested with an undivided one half interest.

J. R. French, also known as John Robert French, died testate as is more fully shown in the Office of the Probate Court for Greenville County in Apartment 1013, File 17, devising his undivided one third interest to Hester Rhoda French so that together with her ownership of an undivided one sixth interest she became vested with an undivided one-half interest.
