

be done between the revocation of these presents by my death or in any other manner and notice of such revocation reaching my attorneys-in-fact; and I hereby declare that as against me and all persons claiming under me everything which my attorneys-in-fact shall do or cause to be done in pursuance hereof after such revocation as aforesaid shall be valid and effectual in favor of any person claiming the benefit thereof who before the doing thereof shall not have had notice of such revocation.

This Power of Attorney shall not be affected by physical disability or mental incompetence of the principal which renders the principal incapable of managing her own estate. In the event of such physical disability or mental incompetence my said attorneys-in-fact shall not be required to file with any court any inventory of all deposits, choses in action and/or personal property, and my said attorneys-in-fact shall not be required to post any bond.

This Power of Attorney shall be revoked by my death or by me in writing.
