Stone Avenue to East North Street
(Name of Place) Spartanburg Street State and County aforesaid, as shown by plans prepared by the City of Greenville on and over all land which I (or we) own and are furtherdescribed below, for the purpose of locating, constructing improving, and maintaining the above described highway with the bridges and causeways thereon, and the right to construct and maintain controlled access facilities to said DERIVATION: Book 710 Page 538, Recorded Nov. 14, 1962 from R. C. Collins Said property is described as follows: BEGINNING at a point on the NE intersection of Hollywood Circle with Spartanburg Street (sometimes called Church Street) and running thence S. 24-46 W. 80.3 feet, more or less, to a point on the Eastern side of Hollywood Circle; thence continuint with Hollywood Circle S. 29-10 E. 35 feet, more or less, to a point at the joint front corner of Lots 1 and 2; thence N. 60-50 E. 125 feet, more or less, to a point at the joint rear corner of Lots 1 and 2; thence N. 29-10 W. 32.3 feet, more or less, to a point on the Southern side of Spartanburg Street; thence with the Southern side of Spartanburg Street N. 62-51 W. 81.5 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning. Said right-of-way is described as follows: Beginning at a point at the intersection of the eastern side of Hollywood Circle and the southern side of Spartanburg Street and running thence in an easterly direction along the southern side of Spartanburg Street to the joint front corner of Lots 190-2-34 and 190-2-5A, such ease ment or right-of-way shall contain any and all portions of the parcel within 16 feet of a centerline of Spartanburg Street as shown on a plat prepared '/ W.
