KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT I (or we) Ansel A. Dacus

in consideration of the sum of One Dollar, to me (or us) in hand paid, and other valuable consideration at and before sealing and delivering thereof, by the City of Greenville, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, and release, unto the said City of Greenville, its successors and assigns, a right-of-way for the construction of a section of the City Roadway, including necessary drainage ditches and sidewalks from

East Stone Ave. to East North Street on (Name of Place) (Name of Place)

Spartanburg Street State and County aforesaid, as shown by plans prepared by the City of Greenville on and over all land which I (or we) own and are further described below, for the purpose of locating, constructing improving, and maintaining the above described highway with the bridges and causeways thereon, and the right to construct and maintain controlled access facilities to said highway:

DERIVATION: Vol. 559, page 353, from Lillian Dacus, recorded August 18, 1956. Said property is described as follows: BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Old Spartanburg Road at the joint corner lots 4 & 5, and running thence with said road S. 64-02 E. 47.5 feet, more or less, to a point; thence still with road S. 66-41 E., to point 2.5 feet, more or less, to an iron pin at corner of lot No. 3; thence with the dividing line of Lot No. 3, S. 22-58 W. 240.6 feet, more or less, to an iron pin; thence N. 28-41 W. 65 feet, more or less, to an iron pin corner Lot No. 5; thence along this line N. 22-58 E. 202.3 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner. See Plat Book Q, Page 19.

Said right-of-way is described as follows: BEGINNING at a point on the southern side of Spartanburg Street joint front corner of lots 4 and 5 and running thence in an easterly direction along Spartanburg Street 47.5 feet, more or less, to a sideline with Lot No. 3, such easement or right-of-way containing any and all portions of the above-described property between baseline and a line designated proposed right-of-way shown on a plat prepared by W. R. Williams, RE & LS October, 1976, and filed in the RMC Office of the County of Greenville. Plat Book SX at page 11-24.

"Special Provisions:" None

Together with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining. It is agreed that buildings, fences, signs or other obstructions will not be erected by me (or us), my heirs, assigns or administrators within the limits of the right-of-way herein conveyed and that such buildings and fences as are now within the limits of the right-of-way herein conveyed will be moved from the right-of-way and restored in as good condition as before moving at the expense of the City of Greenville, South Carolina.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said right-of-way and the rights herein before granted, unto the said City of Greenville, its successors and assigns forever.
