Douglas, Jr. Said property is described as follows: BEGINNING at an iron pin at the northwest corner of the intersection of Spartanburg Street and Mt. Eustis Street (formerly Summit Street) and running thence with the southwest side of Mt. Eustis Street N. 42-20 W. 100 feet, more or less, to an iron pin corner of: ot 36; thence with the line of said lot S. 52-00 W. 41 feet, more or less, to an iron pin corner of Lot 55; thence with the line of said lot S. 42-20 E. 100 feet, more or less, to an iron pin on the northwest side of Spartanburg Street; thence with the north west side of said street N. 52-00 E. 41 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning. Plat Book C, page 236, Greenville County Court House. Said right-of-way is described as follows: BEGINNING at a point on the northwestern side of Spartanburg Street at the joint front corner of Lots 12 and 11 and running thence in a northeasterly direction along the northwestern side of Spartanburg Street 41 feet, more or less, to the northwestern corner of the intersection of Spartanburg Street with Summit (Mt. Eustis) Street and said easement or right-of-way shall contain any and all portions of the abovedescribed property between the baseline and a line designated proposed right-of-way shown on a plat prepared by W. The City of Greenville is committed to building a retaining "Special Provisions:" wall contiguous to the new Spartanburg Street to assure the retention of soil from the above described property. Together with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining. It is agreed that buildings, fences, signs or other obstructions will not be erected by me (or us), my heirs, assigns or administrators within the limits of the right-of-way herein conveyed and that such buildings and fences as are now within the limits of the right-of-way herein conveyed will be moved from the right-of-way and restored in as good condition as before moving at the expense of the City of Greenville, South Carolina. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said right-of-way and the rights herein before granted, unto the said City of Greenville, its successors and assigns forever.
