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damages or demands of whatever name or nature or any manner arisen arising or to grow out of the disputes that have arose concerning the maintenance of fences, clothes line poles, drainage ditches which was the basis of the originally controversy.

3. Both Lois Henson, her heirs and assigns, and Clara Miller, her heirs and assigns, expressly agree that their property lines consisting of the boundary lines between the two pieces of property shall exist as they do of record as of this day.
