APPLICATION TO ABANDON

1. Applicant is the duly appointed trustee in Bankruptcy for W & Enterprises, Inc.

2. The following real property belongs to the bankrupt estate:

S. Highway No. 29 and having according to a plat prepared by Stephen S. Clarkson, Surveyor dated December 31, 1966, the following abutting bounds, to-wit:
