KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, PATRICIA ROBERTS HARRIS, Secretary of Housing and Urban Development, of Washington, D. C., (hereinafter referred to as "Grantor"), for and in consideration of the sum of TWENTY ONE THOUSAND AND NO/100-DOLLARS (\$ 21,000.00 ), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto BETTY T. WILLIAMS

(hereinafter referred to as ("Grantee(s)"), and to the heirs and assigns of said Grantee(s), the following described real estate situate in the County of GREENVILLE, State of South Carolina, to wit:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the Northeasterly side of Havendale Drive, being shown and designated as Lot 18, on plat of Stonewood, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book "4-F", at Page 16, said lot fronts on the northeasterly side of Havendale Drive 100 feet, has a uniform depth of 200 feet, and is 100 feet across the rear.
