POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that I, Marie Elletson Clary, of the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, have constituted, made and appointed and by these presents do constitute, make and appoint my husband, Francis Dill Clary, of Greenville, South Carolina, as my true and lawful attorney for me and in my behalf, in all matters and business in which I have, or may have, any interest whatsoever, with full power and authority, both as to real and personal estates, to sign, execute, perform and deliver any and all written instruments which in the judgment of the said attorney should be signed and executed by me. The power and authority herein given is general and unlimited, but it especially includes the right, power and authority to the said attorney in my name and stead to ask, demand, sue for, levy, recover and receive all such sum and sums of money, debts, rents, goods, wares, dues, accounts and other demands whatsoever, which are or shall be due owing or payable to me, or detained for me in any manner or way of means whatsoever.

My Power of Attorney shall have the right to deposit and to withdraw from any banking account, savings account, or other type of depository, from any bank, savings & loan association, or financial institution, where I may have money, deposits, accounts, or credits. These include, but are not limited to, the Citizens & Southern Bank in Greenville, South Carolina, the South Carolina National Bank. Likewise, my Power of Attorney shall have complete control over any stocks or bonds in like manner being able to sell or buy, trade or exchange the same as he may see fit.

My Power of Attorney shall have the right to handle, care for, control, sell, and dispose of any property, real or personal, that I may own, and to purchase for me any property, real or personal, and to execute deeds of conveyance. The

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
