ALL that tract of land in Saluda Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, being known and designated as Tract No. 3 of the Morgan Home Place, as shown on plat made by G. A. Ellis in April 1938, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at the corner of Tract No. 4 on the Buncorbe Road and running thence with Tract No. 4 N. 52 W. 1060 feet to North Saluda River; thence down said river as a line 239 feet to Tract No. 2; thence with line of Tract No. 2 S. 54-3/4 E. 1100 feet to line of C. L. Hightower land; thence with his line N. 83-1/2 E. 73 feet to the Buncorbe Road; thence with said Buncorbe Road 225 feet to the beginning corner, containing 5.88 acres, more or less.
