ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with all improvements thereon or hereafter constructed thereon situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Grove Township, and being more particularly described as follows as shown by plat made July 14, 1949, by J. L. Hunter, Surveyor:

BEGINNING at a point on U. S. Highway No. 29 and dirt road and running thence with dirt road N. 88-0 W. 250.4 feet to middle of said road and line of J. F. Davis; thence S. 8-05 W. 85 feet with Davis line to iron pin; thence S. 87-55 E. 255 feet to iron pin on right of way of U. S. Highway No. 29; thence with right of way of U. S. Highway No. 29, N. 5-0 E. 85 feet to beginning corner.

This conveyance is made subject to any and all existing and recorded easements, rights of way and restrictions affecting said property.
