

Section 2.05. Drawings of Federated. Within sixty (60) days following the date of final approval by Federated of the Preliminary Drawings for every Phase of Development but in no event prior to September 1, 1978, Federated shall submit to the Project Architect the Federated Drawings consistent with the Plot Plan, the Operating Agreement and this Agreement. After the submission by Federated of the Federated Drawings, the Project Architect shall promptly notify Federated of any objections with respect thereto. Federated shall then cause its architect to meet with the Project Architect and they shall use their best efforts to resolve the objections to the Federated Drawings in order to conform the Federated Drawings with the Plot Plan, the Operating Agreement, this Agreement and good construction standards and practices. The right of the Developer to object under this Section 2.05 shall be limited to the grounds that the Federated Drawings (i) deviate materially from the Federated Drawings previously submitted, (ii) are materially inconsistent with the Plot Plan or (iii) are materially inconsistent with the terms of this Agreement or the Operating Agreement. The failure of the Project Architect to notify Federated of any objections to the Federated Drawings, as originally submitted or subsequently resubmitted, within fifteen (15) days after the date of such submission or resubmission, shall constitute approval by the Developer and the Project Architect of the Federated Drawings.

Section 2.06. Design Plan. As the Preliminary Drawings and Final Drawings for each Phase of Development to be performed by the Developer are approved by Federated and the other Department Stores and the Federated Drawings and the drawings for each of the other Department Stores with respect to the construction to be performed by each of the other Department Stores have been reviewed and approved by the Project Architect, the same shall be deemed to be incorporated in and constitute a part of the Design Plan.
