

- D. Installation of storm drainage and sanitary sewer systems.
- E. Installation of street curbing and gutters.
- F. Paving.
- G. Sidewalks.
- H. Extension of (including any necessary relocation electric, telephone, water, storm drainage and sanitary sewer lines.
- I. Water pressure booster, if necessary.
- J. Traffic control equipment.
- K. Landscaping.
- L. Reasonable architectural, engineering and contractors' fee.
- M. Environmental study fees and costs.
- N. Environmental impact study fees and costs.

ON-SITE IMPROVEMENTS

2. The term "On-Site Improvements" shall mean the installation of all improvements on the Entire Premises reasonably related to the preparation of the Entire Premises for use as an enclosed mall regional shopping center, excluding all buildings, building retaining walls, backfill of building retaining walls, sidewalks adjacent to major department stores and any installations within, or appurtenances to, such buildings made by the parties. On-Site Improvements shall at least include, without limitation, the underground extension of the necessary facilities referred to in (ii)(A), (B), (C) and (D) under Off-Site Improvements, to within five (5) feet of the building lines as required by the parties and the principal tap fees for connection of the water and sewer lines from the Entire Premises to the existing systems.

On-Site Improvements and the cost thereof shall also include without limitation, the following:

- A. Surveys and test borings.
- B. Clearing, grubbing, grading and mucking.
- C. Demolition of existing structures and debris removal.
- D. Mass earth excavation, grading, filling, backfilling and compacting (including the cost of borrow materials and the cost of disposing of excess materials from the Entire Premises, but not to include backfill of building retaining walls, borrow materials for same, or cost of disposing of excess materials from building construction or compaction of any fill material made necessary by building construction).
