

in a proper manner, with poles, wires, guys, conduits, cables, transformers, and other necessary apparatus and appliances, overhead or underground lines for transmitting and distributing power by electricity, and for communication purposes, together with the right at all times to enter said premises for the purpose of inspecting said lines and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon and additions thereto together with the right at all times to cut away or by other means to keep clear of said lines all trees, brush and other obstructions that may, in any way, endanger the proper maintenance and operation of the same; also, including the right to relocate said lines over said premises to conform to any future highway or street relocation, widening or improvements. The right of way conveyed herein shall be within the boundaries of that certain right of way heretofore acquired by the Western Carolina Regional Sewer Authority.

The Respondent is further given the right of assigning such right of way to Duke Power Company, its successors and assigns, or any successor utility.

The property over which the right of way is to cross is identified on the Greenville County Tax Maps as District _____, Sheet B3.1, Block 1, Lot 3, Greenville County, S. C. The right of way taken shall be located on the ground as shown upon a plat on file in the office of the engineer of Western Carolina Regional Sewer Authority

The Appellant herein shall have the right to a trial de nova for the purpose of determining compensation and damage, if any, due to the Appellant by reason of the taking of this right of way.

That upon the signing of this Order, Appellant herein will have perfected his appeal and will be relieved of the obligation to file any further notice of intent to appeal and this case shall be docketed in the Office of the Clerk of Court for Greenville County and placed on the trial calendar.
