All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Dunklin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying on the south side of the Lickville road leading from Cooley Bridge road to the Augusta Road and having the following courses and distances according to survey and plat made by Hugh J. Martin, September 22, 1965 to wit: BEGINNING at a point in the center of said Lickville Road (I. P. 50 feet on line) and the north-eastern corner of the following described lot and running thence S. 22-30 W. 500.9 feet to stone on Bess Cothran line, thence along Cothran line N. 55-00 W. 270 feet to new corner on Coker and Cothran line, thence N. 22-45 E. 471 feet to point in center of said road, I.
