**CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION**  
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS, Jacqueline M. Farrell, 9 Toy St., Greenville, S. C.

which has been duly and regularly organized, did on the 9th day of  
January, A. D. 19 79, file with Secretary of State a written declaration setting forth:

That, at a meeting of the aforesaid organization held pursuant to the by-laws or regulations of the said organization, they were authorized and directed to apply for incorporation.

That, the said organization holds, or desires to hold property in common for Religious, Educational, Social, Fraternal, Charitable or other eleemosynary purpose, or any two or more of said purposes, and is not organized for the purpose of profit or gain to the members, otherwise than is above stated, nor for the insurance of life, health, accident or property; and that three days' notice in the Greenville News Piedmont, a newspaper published in the County of Greenville, has been given that the aforesaid Declaration would be filed.

AND WHEREAS, Said Declarants and Petitioners further declared and affirmed:

FIRST: Their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: The name of the proposed Corporation is THE GREENVILLE ASSOCIATION OF LEGAL ASSISTANTS, INC.

THIRD: The place at which it proposes to have its headquarters or be located is Suite 400, 301 College St. Greenville, S. C.

FOURTH: The purpose of the said proposed Corporation is to further the knowledge of the law and to uphold its honor and dignity by the Greenville County legal assistants, the same being persons who assist attorneys in essentially non-clerical matters.
