

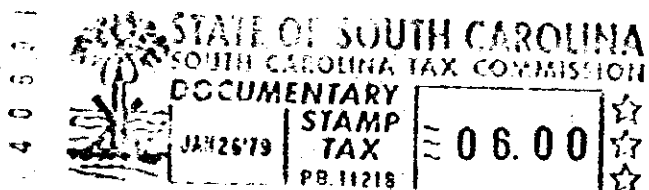
The above-described land is subject to the following-described real estate mortgage(s).
