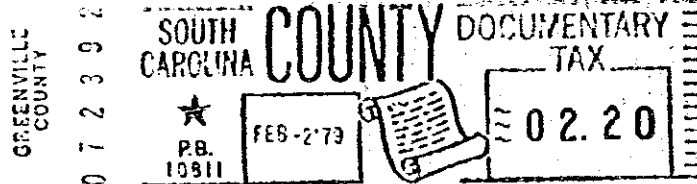
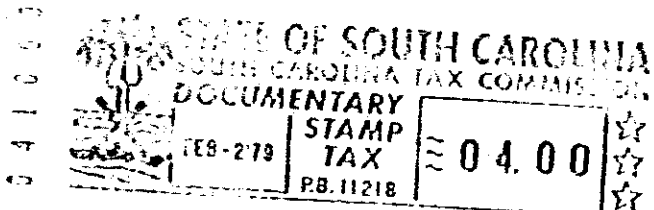
Clyde Hanes Brookshire, his heirs and assigns, forever:
