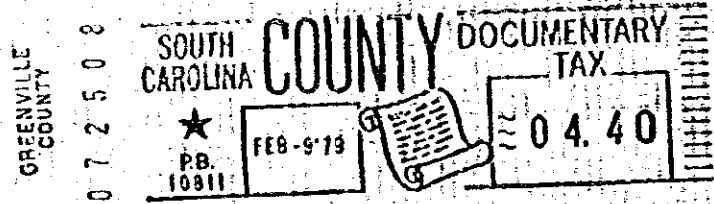
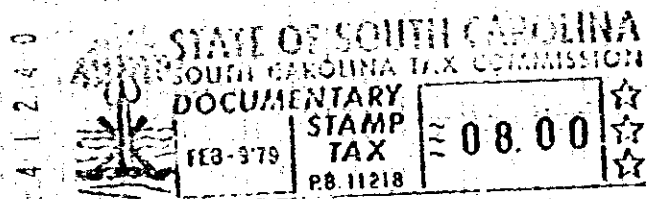
in consideration of THREE THOUSAND, SEVEN HUNDRED, FOURTEEN AND 28/100ths Dollars,
