

POWER OF ATTORNEY

Know all men by these presents, that we, George . Ayers and wife, Barbara Huff Ayers, the undersigned, of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina, hereby make, constitute, and appoint Ellis K. Murphy, of Sparta, Alleghany County, North Carolina, our true and lawful attorney-infact for us and in our names, places, and steads, giving unto the said Ellis K. Murphy, full power to do and perform all and every act that we may legally do through an attorney-in-fact, and every proper power necessary to carry out the purposes for which this power is granted, with full power of substitution and revocation, hereby ratifying and affirming that which Ellis K. Murphy or his substitute shall lawfully do or cause to be done by himself or his substitute lawfully designated by virtue of the power herein conferred upon him.

This Power of Attorney shall relate and be effective only as to our interest in a certain tract or parcel of real estate located in Greenville County, South Carolina, and being more particularly described as follows:
