the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Administrator of Veterans' Affairs, an Officer of the United States of America, whose principal office and post office address is Veterans' Administration, Washington 25, D. C., and his successors in such office, as such and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown and designated as a portion of Lots 26 and 27 as shown on a plat of PARIS HEIGHTS, recorded in the Office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County in Plat Book Y at page 55; said property fronts 71.1 feet on Cataline Drive; runs back to a uniform depth of 160.0 feet; and is 71.1 feet across the rear.
