It is expressly understood that the Purchasers herein shall maintain the said property in a reasonable state of repair, normal wear and tear is excepted.

In the event the Purchasers fail to make any payment as setforth above on its due date as stated in the paragraph above, this Contract shall thereupon terminate at the option of the Seller and all payments made by the Purchasers prior thereto shall be forfeited by the Purchasers to the Seller herein as rent for the use of said premises as liquidated damages for the breach of this Contract.

Upon the Purchasers' paying the consideration herein expressed, the Seller will execute and deliver to the said Purchasers, their heirs and assigns, a good fee simple, title by way of a general warranty deed.

This Contract shall be binding upon the parties hereto, their heirs and assigns.
