All our right, title and interest in and to that certain tract, parcel or lot of land lying and being in Highland Township and Greenville County and in the State of South Carolina, having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances:

BEGINNING on an iron pin on the Salem Church land, running thence S. 20 E., 3.00 chains to a post Oak on the branch, thence down said brance 12.40 chains to a Black Gum on the branch, thence S. 29 E., 1.38 chains to a stake, thence S. 5 W., 7.45 chains to an iron pin; thence S. 47 E., 9.00 chains to a stake near a large Poplar; thence S. 20 W., 1.00 chains to the center of the creek; thence down said creek 29.70 chains to a point on H. G. Barton line; thence N. 60 W., 1.66 to a stake; thence S. 86 1/2 W., 10.12 chains to an iron pin; thence N. 30 W., 43.10 chains to a stake, the McKinney corner; thence N. 64 E., 36.25 chains to an iron pin, the beginning corner.
