KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That I, Horace C. Swannell, as principal, of the City of Greenville, S. C., do hereby constitute and appoint James F. Burgess of the City of Greenville, S. C. as my true and lawful attorney for me and in my name, place and stead, with full power to have and to exercise the following powers and authorities:

- (1) To sell or exchange and convey any property, whether real, personal or mixed, which I may now own or hereafter acquire, specifically including real estate, stocks, bonds or other securities;
- (2) To sign checks withdrawing or transferring funds from any Bank or Savings and Loan institution in which money may be deposited in my name and to accept, collect and endorse any checks, including Social Security checks, drafts or instruments for the payment of money;
- (3) To collect any monies which may become due me and to give receipts therefor;
- (4) To be my lawful proxy and to vote any stock or security I may own or hereafter acquire, and to exercise all rights, privileges and options of said stocks and securities;
- (5) To invest and reinvest from time to time any funds which I may have, in his absolute discretion;
- (6) To prepare and file such tax and other returns as may be required by the State of South Carolina and the United States of America and claims for refunds thereto.
- (7) To have access to such safety deposit box as may be leased by me.
- (8) And, generally, to manage and control my property and to execute any and all instruments necessary or expedient for that purpose as I might do, if personally present.
- (9) This Power of Attorney shall not be affected by physical disability or mental incompetence of the principal which renders the principal incapable of managing his own estate. This provision is being inserted in order to comply with Section 32-13-10 of the 1976 South Carolina Code Supplement.
