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KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that Charlie J. Johnson and Beulah L. Johnson

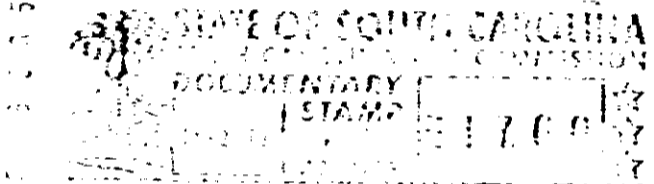
in consideration of Eight Thousand Five Hundred and no/100 (\$8,500.00)----- Dollars,
