the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto INGLESIDE, INC., its successors and assigns forever:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, located, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, containing 4.33 acres, more or less, as shown on plat thereof entitled "Survey for Redmond-Huguenin Enterprises", prepared by Campbell & Clarkson Surveyors, Inc., dated November 10, 1977, recorded in the Greenville County RMC Office in Plat Book 2-7 at Page 14, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit: 12-519-279-2-6.5

BEGINNING at a new iron pin on the Southern edge of the right-of-way of Pelham Road (said new iron pin being approximately 379 feet, more or less, from the intersection of the Southern edge of the right-of-way of Pelham Road and Lamp Post Drive) and running thence, with the Southern edge of the right-of-way of Pelham Road, S. 57-06 E., 247.2 feet to a point in the line of other property of the Mortgagor; thence S. 19-59 W., 802.13 feet to a point; thence N. 82-12 W., 319.8 feet to a point; thence N. 00-18 E., 166.7 feet to an old iron pin; thence S. 78-07 E., 220 feet to a new iron pin; thence N. 12-59 E., 742.6 feet to a new iron pin on the Southern edge of the right-of-way of Pelham Road, the point and place of beginning.
