II. ALL that tract of land lying in the County of Greenville, State aforesaid, near the Community of Fork Shoals, bounded on the northeast by Dunklin Bridge Road, and on the west by Cedar Falls Road and Fork Shoals Road, originally containing 308 acres more or less in four tracts which are hereinafter described (less a tract of three acres which was reserved in the deed to Grantor):

Office in Deed Book 250 at page 409) as follows: N. 69-30 W. 199 feet to a bend in said road; thence N. 48-15 W. 1110 feet to point in said road; thence N. 41-40 W. 1194 feet to the beginning corner. BEGINNING at a point in the center of branch, northeast corner of the tract first above described, and running thence N. 59-45 E. 728 feet to a stone; northwest corner of the tract hereinafter described, and running thence with the line of said tract S. 19-30 E. 660 feet to a stake; thence S. 50-15 E. 1215 feet to a stake; thence S. 59-30 E. 246 feet to a stake in branch, corner Tract No. 1
