"NET PROCEEDS", when used with respect to any insurance or condemnation award, means the gross proceeds from the insurance or condemnation award with respect to which that term is used remaining after payment of all expenses (including attorneys' fees and any other collection expenses) incurred in the collection of such gross proceeds.

"NOTE ORDINANCE" means the Ordinance adopted by the County Board providing for the terms and provisions of the Notes, and any ordinance supplemental thereof and any amendment thereto.

"PENALTY RATE" shall be interest at the rate of eight percent (8%) per annum, or the highest rate permitted by law, whichever is less.

"PERMITTED ENCUMBRANCES" means, as of any particular time, (i) liens for ad valorem taxes not then delinquent, (ii) this Agreement and the Mortgage, (iii) utility, access and other easements and rights of way, flood rights, encroachments and leases that a Licensed Engineer or the Authorized Lessee Representative certify will not interfere with or impair the operations being conducted in the Building (or, if no operations are being conducted therein, the operations for which the Building was designed or last modified), (iv) such minor defects, irregularities, encumbrances, easements, rights of way, and clouds on title as normally exist with respect to properties similar in character to the Project (including, without limitation, the
