the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto LAMAR D. DELANEY and SYLVIA B. DELANEY, their heirs and assigns forever:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land designated as Lot No. 1, containing 3.17 acres, more or less, as shown according to a plat of Tall Pine Estates, prepared by R. B. Bruce, R.L.S., dated 4/12/76, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING on the eastern side of Little Texas Road, containing 3.17 acres and beginning in the center of Little Texas Road at the joint front corner of Lot 1 and 1 A and running thence with said lots, S. 80-31 E. 773.9 feet to the rear corner of said lots; thence with lot 14, N. 7-23 E. 142.8 feet to the joint rear corner of Lots 1 and 2; thence with the line of said lots, N. 75-24 W. 789.8 feet to the center line of Little Texas Road and joint front corner of said lots; thence along the center line, S. 4-40 W. 213.9 feet to the beginning corner.
