KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Benjamin Thomas Breazeale, II,

in consideration of One Thousand Three Hundred Seventy-five & no/100 (\$1,375.00) Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto John F. Mitchell, his heirs and assigns, forever:

All my undivided one-fourth (1/4) interest in all that certain lot, piece, or parcel of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, just north of the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, known and designated as Lot No. 8, as shown on R. E. Dalton's plat recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyances for said County in Plat Book H at Page 33, and having, according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on the West side of Simons Court, on the joint corner of Lots Nos. 8 & 9, approximately 97.9 feet Northward from the "Old Stone Line" and running thence along Simons Court N. 13-49 E. 50 feet, more or less, to a stake on corner of Lot No. 7; thence N. 79-46 W. 117.2 feet, more or less, to a stake on joint corner of Lots Nos. 3, 4, 7 & 8 (this course running along line of Lot No. 7); thence S. 24-37 W. 50 feet, more or less, along line of Lot No. 3 to a stake on joint corner of Lots Nos. 2, 3, 8 & 9; thence S. 79-03 E. 126.5 feet, more or less, along the line of Lot No. 9 to the beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to Samuel J. Corn by Andrea C. Patterson, by deed dated June 8, 1950, and recorded in Book 411, page 464, RMC Office for Greenville County. Samuel J. Corn died intestate on October 11, 1950, leaving his widow, Janie Maggie C. Corn, and their only child, Ruth Marie (Corn) Breazeale, as his only heirs at law. In accordance with Section 21-3-20, Code of Laws of South Carolina, the widow inherited one half interest in this property and the child inherited the remaining one half interest in the property. See Apartment 1346, File 3, Probate Court for Greenville County. Ruth Marie (Corn) Breazeale died intestate on May 2, 1975, leaving two children, Benjamin Thomas Breazeale, II (grantor herein), and Lynnette R. Schroeder, as her only heirs at law. Reference is further made to Deed Book 1117, page 313, wherein Janie M. Corn deeded her one-half interest in this property to grantee herein, on date of December 13, 1979.
