ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Ward 2 of the City of Greenville, known and designated as Lot No. 8 of property of Will Booker on plat made by R. E. Dalton, June, 1924, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "G" at Page 98, and having according to such plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
