

5.02 Any Trustee may resign by a written notice of resignation delivered to any of the remaining Trustees or, if there are no such remaining Trustees, to the Beneficiary.

5.03 Successor Trustees shall be designated or chosen by the remaining Trustee or Trustees. If at any time there shall be no Trustee in office, or if the Trustee or Trustees in office shall be unable or unwilling to appoint a successor or successors, the Beneficiary shall choose such successor or successors.

5.04 So long as any vacancy or vacancies exist in the office of Trustee, the remaining Trustee or Trustees shall continue to exercise and discharge all the powers, discretions and duties hereby imposed or conferred upon the Trustees.

B. Powers of the Trustees

5.05 The Trustees shall have and exercise the absolute control, management and disposition of the trust property with all rights and powers of absolute owners of said property and business free from any power of control on the part of the Beneficiary, subject only to the specific limitations contained in this Trust; and the conferring of any specific powers herein shall not be construed as limiting the general powers herein conferred upon the Trustees.

5.06 Any powers, rights or privileges necessary or appropriate to the carrying out of the purposes of this Trust are hereby vested in and conferred upon the Trustees, including the following specific powers:

- (a) To sell the trust property or any part thereof for cash or on credit and on such terms and con-
