the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell
and release unto Mary L. Dempsey, her heirs and assigns, forever:

All of my one-seventh (1/7) interest in and to the following described real

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County,
State of South Carolina, on the western side of Piedmont Avenue, near the City
of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 5 of the subdivision known
as "Edgemont", according to a plat thereof made by F. G. Rogers in June, 1915,
recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "D" at Page
35, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
