and assigns forever:

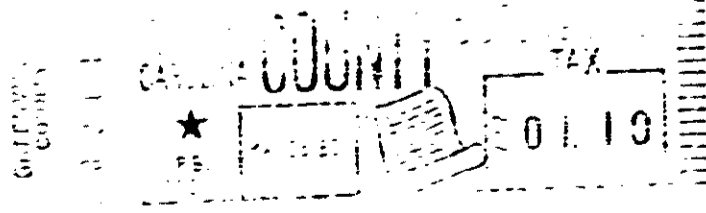
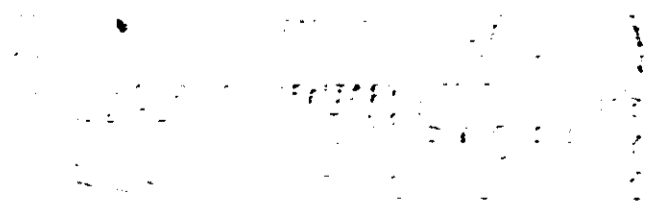
All that lot of land located in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,
