This matter comes before me on motion of James C. Blakely, Jr., of Brown, Byrd, Blakely & Massey, Attorneys for Petitioners, to confirm the report of the Master dated and filed April 17, 1980.

This Action was commenced by the Petition of the Petitioners in which they sought to have the Court issue an order appointing a successor trustee for the purpose of conveying outstanding interests in title to property located in Greenville County, South Carolina, and more fully described in Paragraph 1 of the Petition.

The Summons Notice and Petition were properly served on the Respondent, Thomas G. Crymes, Jr., individually and as representative of the class of persons comprised of the Heirs-at-Law and Devisees of Thomas G. Crymes, Jr., R. D. Sloan and J. P. Trowbridge, Trustees.
