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This is an action to set aside certain conveyances of real estate between Defendants for the purpose of delaying, hindering or defrauding creditors, particularly this Plaintiff, under § 27-23-10, et seq. of the 1976 Code commonly referred to as the Statute of Elizabeth.

The real estate involved in this action is located in Greenville County, SC. The Lis Pendens in this action was duly filed in the Clerk of Court's Office on May 15, 1980 and the Complaint was filed in the Clerk's Office on May 19, 1980.

Defendant Paula Wagner was served with a copy of the Summons and Complaint at Columbia, SC on May 28, 1980. The other two Defendants, in May, 1980, were residing in Saudi Arabia. The Summons and Complaint were mailed to said two Defendants by Registered Mail, Return Receipt, on May 20, 1980 and also Summons and Complaint on said date were mailed to Ambassador John C. West in Saudi Arabia for service on Defendants.

Within twenty days, M. Wallace Smith, Esquire, attorney with the firm of Younts, Gross, Gault & Smith, gave Plaintiff's counsel notice of an appearance on behalf of Defendants and in addition, Defendant Grantland P. Wagner, on Wednesday, June 11, 1980, called W. H. Arnold of counsel for Plaintiff that he and his wife, Mae Joyce W. Wagner, had received the suit papers. Attorney Smith asked Attorney Arnold for an extension of time in which to file Answers by letter dated June 18, 1980 and his request was granted.

Attorney Smith filed his Answer dated July 8, 1980, an Amended Answer with Motion to Amend dated July 31, 1980 and a second Motion to Amend with a second Amended Answer dated August 1, 1980.

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
