

VI. PLOT PLAN, FLOOR PLAN AND AMENDMENT THERETO. A plot plan, showing the property and the layout, location, residence numbers and dimensions of the original stage consisting of twenty-eight (28) units and the common area and limited common area and future stages identified in Exhibit "B" is incorporated hereby by reference and submitted herewith to the RMC Office for Greenville County for filing and recording pursuant to the Act. This plat is recorded in Plat Book 7X, at Page(s) 40 in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, and is herein referred to as the "Plot Plan and Floor Plans."

VII. RESTRICTIONS. For the purpose of insuring maximum enjoyment of the condominium property by all of the residences, the use of the property of the condominium shall be in accordance with the following provisions:

- A. The condominium property shall be used only for single family residences, and for furnishing of services and facilities herein provided for the enjoyment of such residences. Each of the residences for which provision is made by the condominium documents shall be occupied only by a single family as its residence and for no other purpose, except, however, the Association may allow two or more non-related persons to occupy a unit. Also Declarant may use one or more units for a sales office and demonstration unit until Declarant has sold all of its units.
- B. No business shall be allowed upon the condominium property, nor any use of practice which is the source of annoyance to residents or which interferes with the peaceful possession and proper use of the property by its residents. All parts of the property shall be kept in a clean and sanitary condition and no rubbish, refuse or garbage allowed to accumulate nor any fire hazard allowed to exist.
- C. No immoral, improper, offensive or unlawful use shall be made of the condominium property, nor any part thereof; and all valid laws, zoning ordinances and regulations of all governmental bodies having jurisdiction thereof shall be observed.
- D. Entire residences may be rented (the term "rent" shall include lease or sublease). No unit owner may lease less than the entire unit. Any lease agreement shall be required to provide that the terms of the lease shall be subject in all respects to the provisions of the Declaration and the By-Laws and that

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
