D. Earle out of that tract conveyed to him by E. Inman, Master, dated and recorded on April 4, 1933 in the R. M. C. Office for said Greenville County in Deed Book 169, page 87.

This conveyance is subject to all rights of way of record or apparent on the premises.

The grantor's interest in this property was acquired under the will of M. D. Earle, whose estate is of record in the Probate Court for said Greenville County in Apartment 321, File 14. The life tenant, Lila E. Earle, is now deceased. All of the children of M. D. Earle survived her. The said children are Marshall D. Earle, Lila E. Crumpton and Sarah E. Campbell.

This deed conveys the grantor's undivided one-third interest in this lot, and the consideration recited is one-third of the total consideration for the conveyance of entire fee.
