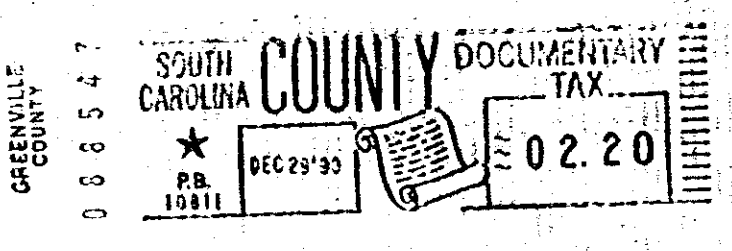
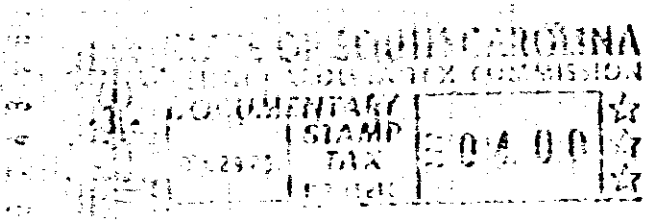

Stokely and Wylene B. Stokely as tenants in common, for and during their joint lives, and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them, his or her heirs and assigns, forever, in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described property, to-wit:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Springwood Cemetery in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, containing two (2) grave sites and being composed of a portion of Lot 90-U of said cemetery, and being bounded by and adjoining the grave sites of Dr. and Mrs. A. S. Pack, the graves of Mr. and Mrs. L. M. Glenn, and a walkway in said cemetery. The grave sites herein referred to are enclosed in a coping and are a portion of the land conveyed to Doctor Alva S.
