All those certain parcels or lots of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, City of Greer, on the North side of Daniel Avenue, being known and designated as Lots Nos. 10, 11, and 12 on a plat of property entitled "D. D. Davenport Estate", prepared by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated August, 1938, recorded in Plat Book K at pages 21 and 22, and having such metes and bounds as is thereby shown. According to said plat said property fronts 361.6 feet on the North side of Daniel Avenue, with a depth on the East of 122.4 feet, a depth on the West of 221.2 feet, and with a rear width of 340.6 feet.

Lot No. 11 having been conveyed to Faith Assembly of God Church of Greer, S. C. by deed of The Pentecostal Holiness Church of Greer, S. C., recorded June 7, 1968, in Vol. 845 at page 597.

Lot No. 10 having been conveyed to Faith Assembly of God by deed of Walter E. Monroe, recorded August 25, 1969, in Vol. 874 at page 388.

Lot No. 12 having been conveyed to Faith Worker Holiness Church by deed of Henry C. Center, recorded January 15, 1974, in Vol. 992 at page 181.

The purpose of this deed being to merely reflect of public record the single ownership of the several church properties, acquired by it at various times, under various prior names of said church.

The congregation of Faith Holiness Church, on June 22, 1980, unanimously adopted a resolution authorizing and directing the Pastor and Trustees of the Church to take such action as would properly reflect the single ownership of the several church properties.
