

or to concur with persons jointly interested with myself there-  
in, in doing all acts, deeds, matters and things herein, either  
particularly or generally described, as fully and effectively  
to all intents and purposes as I could do in my own proper  
person if personally present;

17. To constitute, substitute and appoint in his place and  
stead, one or more attorneys to exercise for me, as my attorney  
or attorneys, any and all of the powers and authorities hereby  
conferred, and to revoke any such appointment from time to time  
and to substitute or appoint any other or others in the place of  
such attorney or attorneys, as he may from time to time think fit.

I do hereby ratify and confirm all things whatsoever my  
said Attorney or his substitute or substitutes, shall lawfully  
do or cause to be done by virtue of these presents, including  
anything which shall be done between the revocation of these  
presents by my death, or in any other manner, and notice of such  
revocation reach our Attorney; and I hereby declare that as  
against me and all persons claiming under me, everything my  
Attorney shall do, or cause to be done, after such revocation  
as aforesaid, shall be valid and effective in favor of any per-  
son claiming the benefit thereof, who, before the doing there-  
of shall not have had notice of such revocation.

This Power of Attorney shall not be affected by my physical  
disability or mental incompetence which renders me incapable of  
managing my own estate. It is my intent that the authority con-  
ferred herein shall be exercisable notwithstanding my physical  
or mental incompetence.
