

3. The number of shares of the corporation outstanding at the time of such adoption was 1,513; and the number of shares entitled to vote thereon was 1,513.

4. The number of shares voted for such amendment was 1,470; and the number of shares voted against such amendment was 3.

5. The amendments herein effected do not give rise to dissenter's rights to payment for the reason that the only effects of such amendments are to change the name of the corporation and the purposes for which the corporation is organized.
