- V. <u>RESTRICTIONS</u>. For the purpose of insuring maximum enjoyment of the condominium property by all of the residents, the use of the property of the condominium shall be in accordance with the following provisions:
 - A. The condominium property shall be used only for single family residences, and for the furnishing of services and facilities herein provided for the enjoyment of such residences. Each of the residences for which provision is made by the condominium documents shall be occupied only by a single family as its residence and for no other purpose.
 - B. No business shall be allowed upon the condominium property, nor any use or practice which is the source of annoyance to residents or which interferes with the peaceful possession and proper use of the property by its residents. All parts of the property shall be kept in a clean and sanitary condition, and no rubbish, refuse or garbage allowed to accumulate nor any fire hazard allowed to exist.
 - C. No immoral, improper, offensive or unlawful use shall be made of the condominium property, nor any part thereof; and all valid laws, zoning ordinances and regulations of all governmental bodies having jurisdiction thereof shall be observed.
 - D. With the exception of a lender in possession of a unit following a default in a first mortgage, a foreclosure proceeding or any deed or other arrangement in lieu of foreclosure, no unit owner shall be
