the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto P. E. Cox, Clarence Cox, Corrie C. Boyd, Flora C. Robinson, Maude Bridges, Sollie C. Maybin, and Doris Day, their heirs and assigns forever,

All of my right, title and interest, the same being inherited by me as heir at law of James Harvey Cox, and the same being inherited by my father, James Harvey Cox, as an heir at law of E. L. Cox and Sollie H. Cox, as well as Larkin Cox, in and to the following described land:

All that land, consisting of a single tract at the time of the death of E. L. Cox, but now divided by survey into two tracts, on the Tugaloo Road, near Marietta, S. C., in Bates Township, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being all of the land owned by E. L. Cox at the time of his death, and all of the land in which Sollie H. Cox owned an interest at the time of her death, and more fully shown on the following plats: (1) a tract of 24.30 acres shown on a plat entitled "Plat of Property of E. L. Cox (Estate)", made by Terry T. Dill, November 14, 1974, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 7J at page 98; and (2) a tract of 1.26 acres, more or less, shown on a plat entitled "Plat of Property of House Lot, E. L. Cox Estate", made by Terry T. Dill, November 14, 1974, recorded in said R. M. C. Office in Plat Book 7J at page 99; reference to both plats being craved for a fuller description.
