

other papers and documents which may be necessary or appropriate in connection with the handling of my affairs or my property;

(e) To retain, invest and reinvest any of my funds in any stocks, bonds, notes or other securities or property, real or personal;

(f) To sell, exchange, assign, or otherwise dispose of any property, real or personal, at any time forming a part of my property, for cash or upon credit, in such manner and on such terms and conditions as my attorney may deem best, and no person dealing with my attorney shall be bound to see to the application of monies paid;

(g) To manage, operate, repair, improve, mortgage or lease for any terms any real estate at any time owned by me;

(h) To continue and/or incorporate any business of mine;

(i) To insure my property against damage or loss and my attorney against liability with respect to third persons;

(j) To employ, discharge and compensate attorneys, agents accountants and other assistants and advisors deemed by my attorney to be necessary or appropriate for the proper management of my property;

(k) To sell and/or harvest growing timber and/or pulpwood in accordance with recommended forestry practices;

(l) To borrow money and to encumber, mortgage or pledge any of my property for any term which my attorney may deem appropriate; and

(m) To compromise, adjust, arbitrate, sue on, defend, abandon or otherwise deal with and settle claims in favor of or against me or my property.

This Power of Attorney shall be recorded in the public records of the county of my residence and shall remain in full force and effect until the earlier of the following events:

(1) my attorney has resigned by delivering to me in writing a copy of his resignation and recording the original in the public
