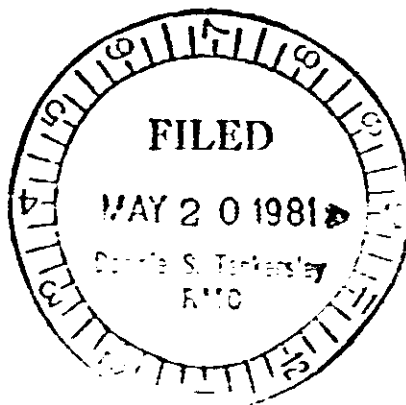

right, title and interest in and to the following described
property:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township,
Greenville County, State of South Carolina, facing one Eli
Street, just off the Cedar Lane Road and has the following
metes and bounds, to wit: BEGINNING at an iron pin joining
alley; S 79-30 E 100 feet along said alley to an iron pin,
joint corner with Mrs. Kay; thence S 3-10 W 52.5 feet to
joint corner of Lot Number 10 and Mrs. Kay; thence N 79-30 W
96.86 feet to an iron pin on Eli Street; thence N 3-10 E
52.5 feet to the beginning corner, being known and designated
as Lot Number 11 on said plat.
