- C. Duties and Powers. Duties and powers of the Association shall be those set forth in the condominium documents, together with those reasonably implied to effect the purpose of the Association and the condominium. Such duties and powers shall be exercised in the manner provided by the condominium documents.
- Manager. Chief executive officer of the Association shall be the Manager, who D. shall be employed upon the favorable vote of a majority of the whole Board of Directors. During his tenure, the Manager shall exercise all the powers, and shall be responsible for performance of all the duties, of the Association as provided in the Act, this Declaration, and the By-laws, excepting only those powers and duties specifically and exclusively assigned to the other officers, the Board of Directors or the members of the Association by the Act, this Declaration or the By-laws. The Manager may be an individual, a corporation, or any other person, as the Board of Directors shall determine. If the Board of Directors determine to discharge the Manager, as authorized above, the Manager shall, if he is a compensated employee of the Association, receive either thirty (30) days notice prior to termination and thirty (30) days salary after termination, or sixty (60) days salary in lieu of any prior notice. The Manager shall be bonded in such amount as the Board of Directors shall require. Any agreement for professional management of the project must provide that the management contract may be terminated at any time without penalty upon not more than ninety (90) days notice and the terms of such contract cannot exceed one (1) year, renewable by agreement for successive one year periods.
- E. Notice. Notice for any purpose may be given by the Association to co-owners and the co-owners to the Association in the manner provided in the By-laws for notice of meetings to members of the Association.
- XI. <u>INSURANCE</u>. Insurance (other than title insurance) which shall be carried upon the common areas and facilities and the residences shall be covered by the provisions set out in Appendix One, which is attached as part of this Declaration. Some of these provisions are summarized as follows:
- A. The Association will carry, at the expense of the co-owners, the following policies:
- 1. Fire and extended coverage on the residences (but not contents) and common facilities for the benefit of the co-owners and their mortgagees in an amount not less than the full insurable value thereof with such deductible amounts as the Board of Directors may determine which amount of coverage shall be adjusted by reappraisal or revaluation of the insured property not less frequently than once every three years.
- 2. Liability coverage covering the common areas and facilities for the benefit of the Association in amounts of not less than \$300,000 for injuries to each person, \$300,000 for each occurrence, and \$300,000 for damage to property.
